





ASSEMBLY - METHOD 1


- 1. Switch on the appliance and extend the mobile pull-out until the installation holes are visible. Ensure that the pull-out is positioned on a surface that offers sufficient space to the front to prevent it from falling.
- 2. Slide the two mounting brackets into the recesses at the rear of the pullout unit, with the 4 mounting holes pointing upwards. Loosely screw on the 8 M4x6 combination screws using a magnetic screwdriver.
- 3. Align the pull-out on the furniture and mark the installation holes on the wall. The angles can be adjusted in the distance to the pull-out.
- 4. Remove the pull-out, drill the installation holes and insert the expansion plugs and fasten the pull-out with 8 M5x35 wall screws.
 - **Attention:** The enclosed mounting material is only suitable for mounting on solid stone walls. Obtain suitable mounting material for your structure.
- 5. Tighten the 8 M4x6 combination screws firmly, but do not overtighten them to finalise the installation.



ASSEMBLY - METHOD 2

- Switch on the appliance and extend the mobile pull-out until the installation holes are visible. Ensure that the pull-out is positioned on a surface that offers sufficient space to the front to prevent it from falling.
- 2. Slide the two mounting brackets into the recesses at the rear of the pullout unit, with the 4 mounting holes pointing downwards. Loosely screw on the 8 M4x6 combination screws using a magnetic screwdriver.
- 3. Align the pull-out on the furniture and screw it in place with the 8 M5x35 wall screws. The angles can be adjusted in distance.
- 4. Tighten the 8 M4x6 combination screws firmly, but do not overtighten them to finalise the installation.

Note: To attach the pull-out to a piece of furniture, you should use 8 screws whose length and diameter are adapted to the respective situation to avoid damage to your furniture.




START-UP AND OPERATION

Insert the plug into the socket and make sure the voltage is correct (220-230 V).

Programming the remote control:

Note: The remote control is already paired at the factory. No pairing is necessary.

If you need to re-pair the remote control, then follow the instructions below. Within 10 seconds of connecting the device to the power supply, press the 'In' and 'Stop' buttons on the remote control simultaneously for 2-3 seconds. The pull-out moves forwards and backwards once, indicating that the remote control has been successfully paired.




SETTING THE STOP POINTS WITH THE REMOTE CONTROL

Method for setting the end position in the extended state:

- 1. Use a paper clip to press the programming button on the back of the remote control. The LED lights up.
- 2. Press the 'Out' button on the remote control, the pull-out will extend. Press the 'Stop' button when it reaches the desired position.
- Use the paper clip to press the programming button on the back of the remote control again. The LED goes out. The pull-out moves forwards and backwards once and the setting of the extended end position is successfully completed.

Method for setting the end position in the retracted state:


- 1. Extend the platform a little if it is fully retracted.
- 2. Use a paperclip to press the programming button on the back of the remote control. The LED lights up.
- 3. Press the 'In' button on the remote control, the pull-out retracts. Press the 'Stop' button when it has reached the desired position.
- 4. Use the paper clip to press the programming button on the back of the remote control again. The LED goes out. The pull-out moves forwards and backwards once, and the setting of the retracted end position has been successfully completed.



OPERATION ON THE PLATFORM

Manual control via the cycle button on the front follows this operating scheme: OPEN-STOP-CLOSE-STOP-OPEN etc.

Each press of the button triggers the next function in the cycle.



SETTING THE STOP POINTS WITH CYCLE BUTTON

The method for setting the end position in the extended state:

Press and hold the cycle button for 5 seconds, the buzzer will "beep" once and then "beep" again to set the limit value in the open state. Move the platform to the corresponding position and press and hold the cycle button for 3 seconds, the buzzer sounds "beep, beep" twice and the setting of the limit value in the open state is complete.

Method for setting the end position in the retracted state:

Press and hold the cycle button for 3 seconds, the buzzer will "beep" once to set the limit value in the retracted state. Move the platform to the corresponding position and press and hold the cycle button for 3 seconds, the buzzer will sound "beep, beep" twice and the setting of the limit value in the closed state is completed.

Reset the settings:

Press and hold the cycle button for 8 seconds, the buzzer will sound "beep, beep, beep" three times and the mobile platform reset is complete.
