




Step 3: Mount Camera Bracket


Attach the Camera Bracket to the lower part of K-Bar to mount the camera onto a display.

To attach the Camera Bracket:

1. Attach the Camera Bracket to the lower part of the K-Bar, using the screw supplied with the K-Bar wall mount kit (included in the K-Bar package).



2. Once the bracket is connected, move the bracket handle to the desired angle.












- 3. Place the K-Bar onto the display.
- 4. Press the handle against the rear side of the display to ensure that the bracket is tightly secured.





- Before moving the display, take care to remove the Camera Bracket to prevent the K-Bar from falling.
- Once installed, do not move the bracket to the sides or push it in any way.
- Ensure that the environment (e.g., maximum ambient temperature & air flow) is compatible for the device.
- Avoid uneven mechanical loading.
- Reliable earthing of rack-mounted equipment should be maintained.
