3. SAFETY

3.1 HOW TO USE THE PRODUCT SAFELY



WARNING

Read and understand this guide and its safety instructions before using this product. Failure to do so can result in serious injury.

3.1.1 VULNERABLE PEOPLE SAFETY INFORMATION

This device is not intended for use by persons (including children) with restricted physical, sensory or intellectual capability or lack of experience and/or knowledge.

The projector complies with the safety standards for electromagnetic devices. Contact your physician prior to use if you have a pacemaker or other implanted device.

3.1.2 TECHNICAL LIFE SPAN

The technical lifespan of the projector is five years or 20,000 hours of use in normal mode and 30,000 hours of use in ECO mode under normal operating conditions (whichever comes first).

3.1.3 INTENDED USE SAFETY INFORMATION

Use the projector only for its intended use as described in this user guide. Do not expose the projector to temperatures above $104 \, \text{F} / 40 \, \text{C}$ or below $32 \, \text{F} / 0 \, \text{C}$.

3.1.4 INSTALLATION SAFETY INFORMATION

Check the projector for damage before installation. If there is any visible damage, do not connect the projector and contact ScreenPlay.

Do not install the projector:

- Near heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other devices that produce heat
- · Near water or in direct sunlight
- In an enclosure such as a book case or a cabinet that restricts air flow



3.1.5 ELECTRICAL SAFETY INFORMATION

Check for damage before connecting the power cable.

Only connect the projector to a grounded socket with earth leakage protection using the provided power cable.

Immediately unplug the projector from the wall outlet:

- · If it has been damaged
- If water or another substance enters the projector
- If you smell smoke or other odours coming from the projector
- During lightning storms
- · When unused for long periods of time

3.1.7 MAINTENANCE SAFETY INFORMATION
